Usage (host)

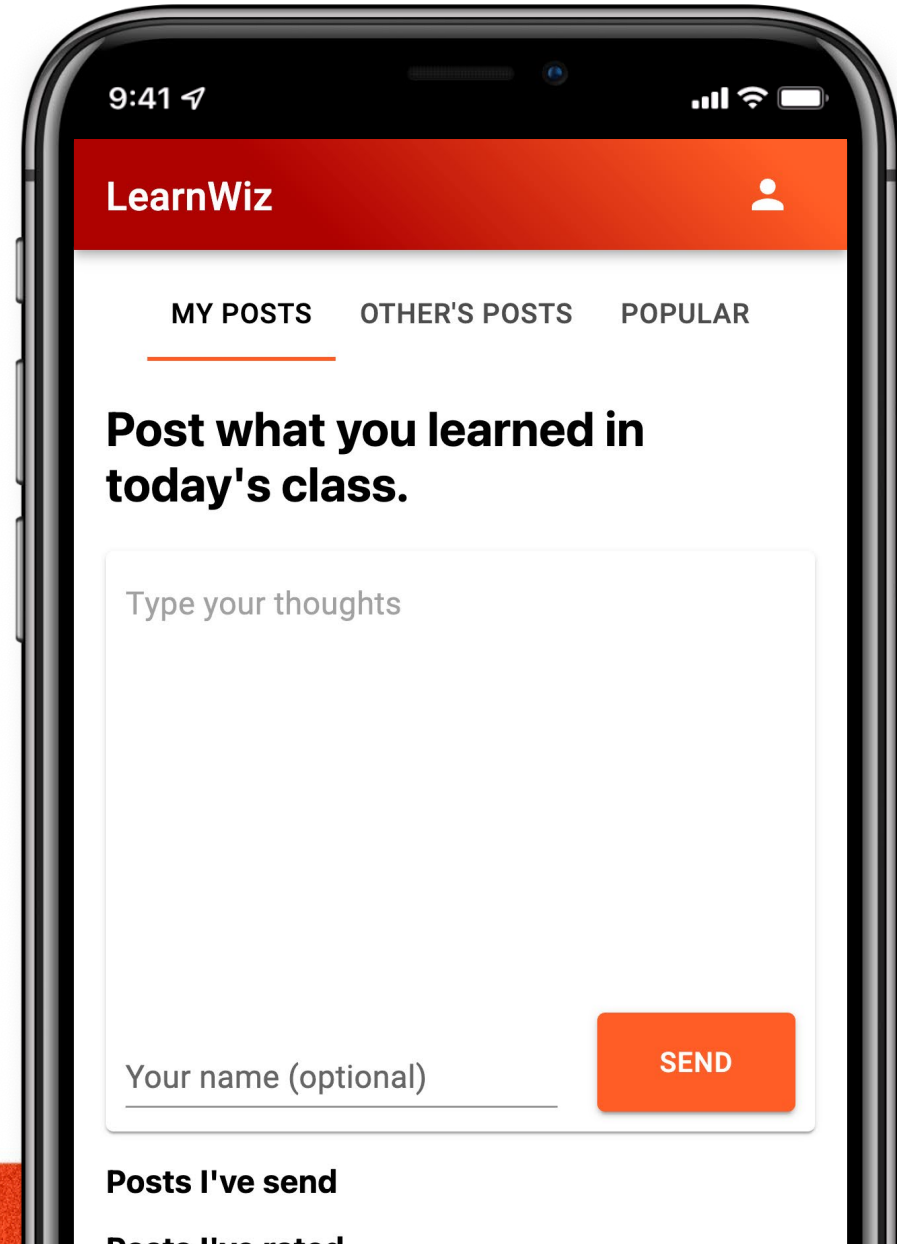
Sign in with a Google account

Create a topic

- Set topic code and question

Manage a topic

- Set items for display
- Set timer
- Delete a topic



Use case 1: ask questions to students

1. Create a topic

2. Make students send their posts in **My posts**

- Leave only "My posts" visible and allow time for them to write answers to questions.
- Set a timer if necessary.

3. Make students check posts in **Others posts**

- Make "Others posts" visible and ask them to review the others posts and "like" the ones they want to share with others.
- Set a timer if necessary.

4. Check popular posts in **Popular**

- You can also check popular posts in admin view.

Example of use case 1: ask questions to students

In a professional development workshop

where teachers can share their classroom practices and discuss what is good about their lessons and what can be improved

Participants

- post the good points of the lesson in the first topic (3 mins)

- check posts of others about good points (2 mins)

- post the points that could be improved in the second topic (4 mins)

- check posts of others about the points that could be improved (2 mins)

- share opinions with the whole class

Use case 2: get questions from students

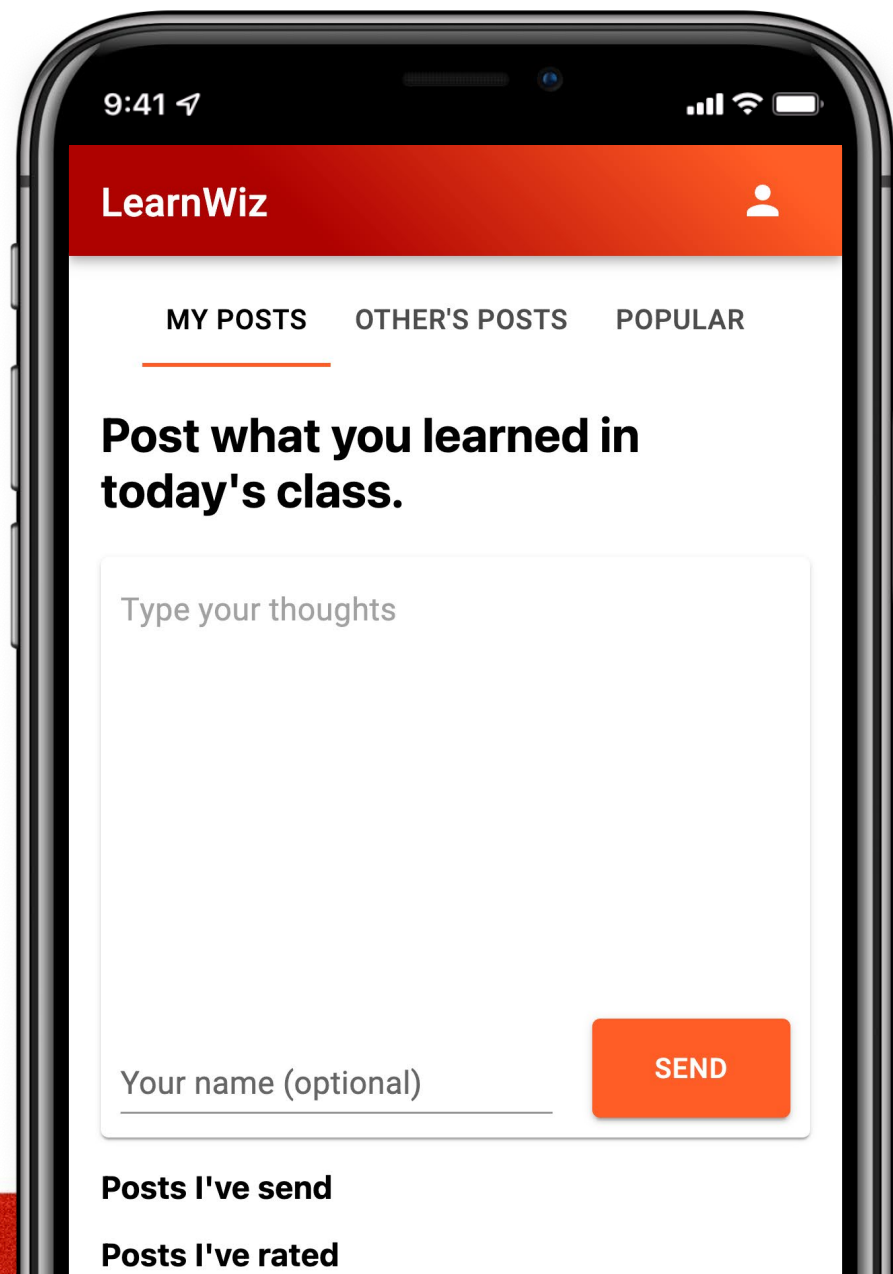
1. Create a topic

2. Make students send their posts and check others posts

- Leaves only "My posts" and Others post visible (Popular invisible). Then students will check others posts after sending their own ones.

3. Check popular posts in Popular

- You can also check popular posts in admin view.
